

Post-Arrest Procedure in Spartanburg County, South Carolina

Overview

This document provides a general overview of post-arrest procedures in Spartanburg County, South Carolina, including booking, bond determination, and release processing.

Arrest and Booking

Following arrest, individuals are transported to the Spartanburg County Detention Center for intake, fingerprinting, and processing. Timing varies based on staffing and charge type.

Bond Determination

Bond may be set by a magistrate or during a bond hearing, generally within twenty-four (24) hours, subject to statutory authority.

Release from Custody

Once bond is posted, detention staff initiate release processing, which may take several hours.

Conditions of Release

Individuals released on bond must comply with all court-imposed conditions or risk revocation and re-arrest.
